The Calhoun County Road Commission (CCRC) will be doing  
chip and seal operations on:

**F Drive South from 25 ½ Mile Road to M-99**  
**H Drive South from 29 Mile Road to 30 Mile Road**  
**J Drive South from 29 Mile Road to 30 Mile Road (along with a .60 mile double seal)**  
**J Drive South from 29 Mile Road to M-99 (complete double seal)**  
**Condit Road from F Drive South to H Drive South**  
**Condit Road from M-99 to D Drive South (complete double seal)**  
**D Drive South from 25 ½ Mile Road to Condit Road**  
**D Drive South from 24 Mile Road to 25 ½ Mile Road**

during the weeks of:

**JUNE 21 - 24, 2010**  
**JUNE 28 – July 1, 2010**

**\*WEATHER PERMITTING:** Please note that chip and seal operations are dependent upon dry weather. Rain showers or even the threat of rain showers will delay seal coating.

The Chip and Seal process is a moving operation that consists of applying a thin layer of oil followed by a layer of small stones. This process improves the existing road by sealing cracks to prevent further damage by water, ice, snow, etc. After the process is completed, loose stones may be present. This will lessen as vehicles travel the road and the stones are compacted into the road surface. Please follow all speed advisory signs. Traveling at speeds in excess of those advisory signs may spray the stones and damage the roadway.

- Our crew will be on-site from approximately 6 am – 4:00 pm, Monday-Thursday.
- Please do not park vehicles on the road. Any vehicle that is parked on the road during this time will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Your road will be closed and access denied for a short period of time during the chip and seal process.
