CALHOUN COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION-READY FOR WINTER

The Calhoun County Road Commission (CCRC) is once again prepared to fight the snow this winter. To provide the most efficient and effective snow removal on our roads, CCRC follows a policy that prioritizes snow removal as follows: State trunk lines/expressways, primary roads, major local roads and residential/subdivision streets.

Our crews remove accumulated snow and ice from the roadway by plowing and/or applying salt or a salt/sand mix, depending on current and predicted weather conditions. On local roads, a salt/sand mix will be used on hills, curves, and intersections only. Local roads and residential/subdivision streets will not be cleared on overtime.

Our crews maintain our roads from 6:45 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. and again from 6:00 p.m. until 2:30 a.m., Monday through Friday. We are available 24 hours a day to handle road and weather related emergencies and continuously communicate with 911 dispatchers to respond to medical or other emergencies on our roads.
